In bloom: late March - early April
Along Sunagawabori in Kotesashicho, Tokorozawa City (around 500 m)




Sunflower Field (Mikajima)

In bloom: early - late August
4-2998-1 Mikajima, Tokorozawa City



Azuma River Cherry Tree Path

In bloom: late March - early April
Along Azuma River from Tokorozawa City's Nishi-araicho to Higashi-tokorozawa (around 5.4 km)



Tokoro Buses

Tokoro Buses run on circular routes around the city. There are six routes departing from either Koku Koen Station or Shin-tokorozawa Station. Fares are between 100 and 270 yen. You can use prepaid transportation cards allowing reciprocal use nationwide, such as PASMO or Suica. There is also a one-day pass which allows you to ride on all six Tokoro Bus routes as many times as you like during the day. This one-day pass, which is convenient for sightseeing, is on sale on board the buses (cash only).
